

Dear all,

here comes some final information regarding the FRISP conference. You will find information about the shuttle bus from Arlanda to Årsta havsbad on June 11, the ferry boat, the icebreaker on the evening of June 11, and some other practical information.

*** Please bring your own name-tag! We are sure you have one from a conference you attended previously! Wear it during the icebreaker BBQ, and it might inspire interesting conversations (“Oh, did you go to *that* conference?”)***

Shuttle bus on June 11:

There will be two shuttle buses from Arlanda to Årsta havsbad on June 11.

The first shuttle bus departs at 15:30 outside Terminal 5. Follow the usual signs for 'bus', and you should be able to find our chartered bus. As parking in the bus-lane is not allowed, our bus driver will not be able to stand and wait there in the lane for a longer period of time. Please be in time! The bus will be marked FRISP. The bus will reach the ferry at 17.50 in Årsta havsbad. Depending on the traffic situation (rush-hour), the bus trip may take that long, but it may also be that we arrive somewhat earlier in Årsta havsbad.

The second shuttle bus departs at 19:30 outside Terminal 5. Follow the usual signs for 'bus', and you should be able to find our chartered bus. As parking in the bus-lane is not allowed, our bus driver will not be able to stand and wait there in the lane for a longer period of time. Please be in time! The bus will be marked FRISP. The bus will reach an extra-taxi boat that we ordered to depart from Årsta havsbad at around 20.45. All late arrivals at Arlanda, please go directly to the bus so that we can stick to departure by boat at 20.45! Please contact our bus driver (Krister Junghahn) if you are late: +46-738 465613.

Ferry Årsta havsbad – Utö Gruvbryggan June 11:

Participants traveling to Utö individually/on the first shuttle bus:

When onboard the ferry, please mention to the staff that you belong to the FRISP group. You will NOT have to buy a ticket, as they will directly bill us (local organizing committee).

Notice that this now works even for individual travellers (rendering earlier information on how to pay for the boat if one is NOT on the shuttle bus OBSOLETE).

When arriving at Utö Gruvbryggan:

Take the path that goes up-hill, follow it for ca 200m. The path will lead you directly to Utö värdshus. You will walk by a number of red huts – these are our accommodations (except for those who have booked single room in the hotel). If you have heavy luggage, you might want to leave it there instead of carrying it up and down. At Utö värdshus, please go to the reception, where you will get your keys. Make yourself comfortable in the huts. The huts have 2 bedrooms, and are equipped with a small kitchenette, including a fridge, and bathroom with shower/wc of course.

Icebreaker BBQ on June 11:

There will be a BBQ at 'Seglarbaren' at the harbour of Gruvbryggan from 20-22 pm. Food and two drinks are free of charge, from the third beer and onward, you have to pay for yourself :)

Excursion on Wednesday June 13:

Our guide, Joakim Mansfeld from Stockholm University, is preparing some material that you can read prior to/during/or after the excursion. This excursion guide (in pdf-format) will soon be available for download on the FRISP homepage.

Internet at Utö värdshus:

Wireless internet is available free of charge in the conference room, restaurant, hotel, and the huts.

Store

There is a store on Utö ('ICA') where you can buy almost everything (food, toiletries, postcards,...). It has generous opening hours and is located very close to the pier 'Gruvbryggan'. Standing on the pier, looking uphill to the värdshus, the ICA is ca 150 m down the first 'street' to the right.

Travel Utö – Årsta havsbad – Arlanda June 14:

The majority of participants will depart from Utö with the 14.25 boat. We will provide a shuttle bus which can take at most 48 persons to Arlanda Airport. Depending on flight times and travel plans, we may be able to arrange for one stop in Stockholm City. We suggest to update the travel plans for departure during the conference, and do a fine-planning while being at Utö. If more than 48 people need to go to Arlanda on June 14, public transport or joining a local participant that came by car may be an option.
